

Patient´s Information – Spermogramm

Dear Patient

Thank you for choosing our laboratory for your sperm analysis (site 1210 Vienna, Kürschnergasse 6b or 1150 Vienna, Meiselstraße 8). Following you will find some important information about this analysis. An **appointment by phone (260 53-203)** is absolutely necessary. At the appointed time you can either produce a sample at site or hand-over your **elsewhere produced sample**. If produced on site please leave the booth as soon as possible to ensure optimal time scheduling.

What to do before the analysis?

To facilitate an optimal prediction of the sperm quality we recommend a minimum of 2-7 days of sexual abstinence.

Sample production

The analysis of the material should start as soon as possible after producing the sperm. Outside the body the motility of the sperms decreases rapidly. **Samples which are not produced at the laboratory site have to be put in a urine container and brought into the laboratory within 45 minutes.** The sample has to be kept at room temperature at all times. Urine containers may be obtained at one of our sites or from any pharmacy.

Aim of the Analysis

The spermogram offers the opportunity to analyze the sperm-number and -motility in the ejaculate. A decrease of the sperm number or motility could cause reduced fertility. Austrian health insurances cover the costs of analysis only if infertility is suspected or in case of inflammation of the prostate. In all other cases, e.g. control analysis after ligation of the spermatic cord (sterilisation, vasectomy), the costs of Euro 37,-- will have to be paid privately.
