

Collection of acidified 24-hours-urine

Precautions

Additional to the collecting vessel you will get a container with a small quantity of concentrated hydrochloric acid. Please note the following warnings:



- Before starting the urine collection, pour the hydrochloric acid into the collecting vessel (please use household/cleaning gloves!)
- Keep the container tightly closed and transport it in upright position (risk of leakage)!
- Avoid direct contact with eyes and skin (risk of chemical burns)!
- Do not directly urinate into the vessel, but use clean cups (no detergents!) to collect the urine and pour it into the collection vessel!
- Keep the collection container out of range of children!

Instructions

- In the morning empty bladder into the toilet and note the time.
- Start with the next emptying of the bladder and continue until next morning. Collect the entire amount of urine and pour it into the vessel.
- Finish collecting urine the next morning about the time listed on the previous day (24 hours).
- The exact quantity of the collected urine is needed for a correct evaluation.

Option 1: Deliver the collection vessel to the lab.

Option 2: Note the exact quantity of urine in the collection vessel. Close the collection vessel tightly and swing it 180 degrees (do not shake), mix well, then fill in a urine sample immediately into a cup provided by Labors.at, and bring it to the lab. Please enter all required data and hand in this form with the urine cup.
